JOBS IN DEMAND TOMORROW

Do you need to make a change in your career now?


Why make a list of jobs that will be required in the future? Firstly, you may want to know how secure your current job or industry is, and then maybe consider making a change in your profession. Secondly, if it is too late for you to make that change, you will be able to better guide your children or the next generation so they have a better chance of making a decent living in the future.

The COVID-19 environment has led the world on a roller coaster ride and every job has been affected one way or another. Jobs once considered safe is no longer, and new demands are being created in certain industries. Regardless, everyone has to adapt.

In general, we feel that everyone should follow their passion, whatever it is, because when you are passionate, there is a higher chance that you will be good at it. Therefore, if you are a parent, we suggest that you do not force your child to study or pursue something they are not interested in because they may grow up miserable and stuck in jobs they hate. They may even end up hating you. The recommended way is still to observe and interact with them so to get to know what their own interests are, and then guide them to achieve the best results they can.

This is a guide and is not meant to be an exhaustive or comprehensive list. This does not necessarily mean they will be the best paying jobs though. We will also focus our attention on jobs that are needed today and will be on the rise in the near future.

Let's begin. Technology is a very large and growing sector. We are living in a new age of technology, and things do not seem to be slowing down. The fact is, our smartphones are more powerful than the early computers. Whether we realise it or not, we are reliant on technology on a daily basis. It has become a necessity. If you don't believe me, try not touching your handphone, tablet or computer for a week.



Some jobs that are required more and more in this sector are User Experience (UX) Developer, Software engineer, Mobile Application Developer, Artificial Intelligence or Machine Learning Engineer, Computer Hardware Engineer... just to name a few.

Two of the more obvious and common jobs from the list above that we rely on a daily basis are 1) User Experience (UX) Developer and 2) Mobile Application Developer. The first job deals with how the end-user physically use the device or app. Is it more natural to swipe-left, swipe-right, pinch, expand or zoom? The flow of using the device/app must feel logical and natural, to the point where the end-user will be able to use it immediately.



If you are the creative type with a strong sense of logic, you may well be suited for this job. Part of the satisfaction you will get is how simple everyone thinks the app is to use. We are all end-users, and one thing you will notice is the application on your device that you use the most is the one that is most "natural feeling", this is courtesy of the UX Developer.



The second job is also very in-demand because we all use and need apps on our phones. Let's be honest, where apps are concerned, there is already something out there for everyone and everything. The challenge for a Mobile Application Developer is how do they improve on what is already there, or how do they make existing apps better. At the highest level, this job will require you to come up with something so simple and useful that everyone will want to use. Whatsapp is a great example. It is a messaging app, which is not a new thing. But it contains usable features that everyone wants to use. And it is very easy to use.

An example of developing a new food app: you have to ask yourself... why would someone use your food ordering app as opposed to another? Rule of thumb is, 1) make it easier to use, 2) give a wider variety of choices, in this case, for food, 3) reliability of service provided and assurance of quality and lastly, 4) give attractive incentive for people to keep using it. You will need a good problem-solving skill for this, but not so much the creative side as most apps have a clear and specific end goal already set.



Another important scope of jobs will be in technology support. Good news is you don't need to be a genius, but you will need to be good with machines and/or software. This will enable you to be the go-to person to solve and fix problems with computers, tablets or handphones. These will all be essential devices for everyone in the near future.

Something at the highest level of jobs found in technology category, and pays significantly more would be Artificial Intelligence (AI) or Machine Learning Engineer. This job will focus mainly on automation. The job is to "teach" computers to "understand" how things work in the real world so machines can do what we do. If it has to do with roles like in the service or medical industry, how to interact with humans and provide a service.

These engineers will build programs that control the machines to help the machine to recognise patterns by giving it data that leads to a logical conclusion. The simplest way to describe this is A must happen first before B.

One day, AI machines may take over the Doctors job in your local clinic on a General Practitioner level. This can be achieved by using all the data related to any common sickness, so the AI can find out what is wrong and prescribe the right medicine. Basically, it is a process of narrowing down of what is wrong with the patient based on what the symptoms are.



The medical and healthcare sector will also see a growing need in terms of personnel. Quite the opposite of the machine-based solution above, humans are required in these jobs. Healthcare jobs that help the elderly will be in demand as the longevity of both man and woman increases due to the advances in medical science.

The list is endless and will include the typical Surgeons, Specialists, Doctors, Nurses, Medical assistants, EMT/Paramedics, Dentists, Pharmacist, etc.

While the higher paying jobs like surgeons and specialist are highly desirable, especially in Malaysia where status is a priority, other jobs that are ignored like Physiotherapists and Physical Therapists should be considered. They are the ones who will deal one-on-one with the patient, helping with general mobility of the elderly, or those who are recovering from an operation, disease, or accident. This is something that robots or programs are still unable to achieve.



Dental care will also be a growing industry, so anything to do with dentistry is pretty safe. Slightly below the perceived "premium job" category are therapy assistant, medical assistant, physician assistant, research assistant, nursing assistant, etc. Regardless, these are decent paying jobs that will be in demand as people live longer.

Cardiologists will also continue to be in demand as heart failure is the leading cause of death for many. This can be due to diseases or simply old age, where the body naturally wears down.

Other changes detected within international and local trends are the next generation putting less and less emphasis on ownership of cars and properties. While this may be the case, they still need to move around and have a place to stay. Therefore, local logistic personnel like delivery or transport services will be high in demand, but may not pay that well as an Artificial Intelligence (AI) or Machine Learning Engineer. Likewise, owning a property will enable you to rent it out to the next generation, making rental a source of income.



The Media and Communications industry will grow. People will still need to know what is happening, so news, entertainment, and sports content is important. People will still need to make purchases for their daily needs and lifestyle, so product development and marketing personnel will be required to market and sell products and services. People still need to communicate with one another, on a professional and personal level, so communications remains in this growth area of jobs in demand.

And finally, recognise what is a stop-gap measure and what can be built into a career. Many are getting into the food business now because they have lost their primary jobs. Can this help you with the finances for the short-term? Yes. Can you make it into a career? No, unless you are 1) a fantastic chef, 2) offering great tasting meals at 3) good prices with 4) a guarantee of consistent quality and 5) quick delivery nationwide. Remember that all of us can cook, but not everyone will want to eat what we can cook.



While jobs that are considered premium in Malaysia are typically Doctors, Engineers, Lawyers and Accountants, this will be the case only in the mindset of the older generation. The harsh reality is, those who can adapt in a rapidly changing and uncertain times are the ones who will actually thrive and be the most successful. This will be key for your survival where jobs are concerned. Adapt... or die.



10(+1) REASONS WHY HIGH-RISE LIVING IS BEST

Thinking of making the transition to an apartment or condominium? Read on.




The concept of living in high-rise abodes is certainly not new in the 21st century, but many, especially the older set, still struggle with it. In essence, the issue is historical and therefore a part of human DNA. For the longest time, man have always lived at ground level, therefore it feels the most "normal".

But land being what it is, is a limited resource, so if you want a good location, a high-rise will be the best option. Sure,

you have to share it with many others, but since you have your own space, these neighbours are usually out of sight and mind.

Having lived on both types of living spaces for an extended period, there is much to be said for a high-rise home. Here are a few reasons to take the higher road, but do note that not every high-rise apartment or condominium will have all the features listed here.



1. Location

As mentioned briefly above, it is easier for a developer to offer a good location to many more people, at a more affordable price if they built a high-rise. So if you want a specific, and good location, now you can afford it without robbing a bank or selling a kidney.

2. Security



Any good apartment or condominium will factor in security and security personnel. If you are living at ground level in a terraced neighbourhood, chances of a break-in by robbers is significantly higher. In high-rise abodes, there are also multi-tiered security features which may include secured access card, CCTV, secured parking lots, card-enabled lifts, security personnel making rounds within the premise, and visitors will also have to register themselves.

Additionally, the land where the apartment or condo is built has a smaller foot-print compared to a sprawling terraced neighbourhood, which means it is easier to keep secured 24/7.

3. Privacy



Usually, the design is such that there is only the main door that is connected to the outside, which means you have complete privacy. Sure, you are sharing your high-rise with a couple of hundred units, maybe more, but you won't even notice it, because once you are inside your home, you literally shut everything else outside. The only footfalls are those who make that short walk to their own units on your floor.

4. Quieter and more peaceful

Less footfalls means less people in close proximity to your front door, this is translated to less noise. Plus the higher up you are, the farther you are from the noise at the ground level, which will include traffic and humans. All these adds to the sense of peace you will encounter.



5. Great views

The higher you go, the better the views. This is something that ground-dwellers will never get, and they have no idea what they are missing. If you face the sunrise or sunset, be prepared for a daily masterpiece, free of charge. You will also be able to appreciate the skyline, many kilometers away, or maybe even get to see a couple of mountain ranges. And at night, you have your own private, unrestricted view of the moon and the stars.



6. Natural ventilation and light

At ground level, unless you are staying in a large bungalow... on top of the highest hill in the area... you can forget about ventilation. With high-rise apartments or condos, almost every floor will receive some form of natural ventilation that is a world away from the stuffy, ground-level, pollution-infused terrace houses. Natural light is also a given, with every unit having one or more sides facing the outside.




7. Less insects

Less incidences of dengue and other pesky tropical insects.



8. Private amenities



It is like having your own pool, gym, sports court, running and cycling track, park, BBQ area, children's park, water-feature, fountain, movie rooms, meeting rooms, library, optical cables, dedicated wi-fi facilities... and the list goes on. In essence, it is a bit like resort-living as all these amenities are at your door-step. You also don't have to worry about trash being collected and the general maintenance of the premise. 



Private amenities

With up to 37 amenities and facilities, you will be spoilt for choices. 


How to perform Heimlich maneuver

Choking on food can happen to **anyone** at anytime. On the "unintentional death" category, death from choking on food is fourth on the list. Therefore, it is a **great idea** to prepare for this.

The name given to this life-saving technique is **Heimlich maneuver**. This move, when done correctly, lifts the diaphragm, forces air out of the lungs, and dislodges the food that is causing the **blockage**.

For babies or toddlers


- 1 Sit down and hold the infant **facedown on your forearm**, which should be resting on your thigh.
- 2 Give **five** back blows gently with the heel of your hand.
- 3 If that doesn't work, position the infant face up and resting on your forearm and thigh so **their head is lower than their trunk**.
- 4 Place **two fingers** at the center of their breastbone and perform **five quick chest compressions**.



Repeat the back blows and chest thrusts until the object is expelled and the infant can breathe or cough on their own.

For adults

- 1 Instruct and help person to stand up. At the same time, try to **calm the person**.
- 2 Get behind the person. Lean the person forward and **give a few blows** to their back with the heel of your hand.



- 3 Place both your arms around their waist. **Make a fist with your dominant hand** and place it just above the navel of the person, thumb facing to person's body.

With your other hand, hold the fist, pull it towards and push it **inward and upward** at the same time. Perform **five** of these abdominal thrusts.



Repeat until the object is expelled and the person can breathe or cough on their own.

5. **Do not surprise or scare someone** while they are eating, as their reaction may cause them to choke on food.




